## Didn't see that coming...

*Slight* change of plans. During the first week of a 40-day fast we received some big news.

The SEND North council and the board of the Northern Light Network have been wrestling with this question for years: "Does the function of KRSA Radio in Petersburg align with SEND International's mission to engage the *unreached*?" On March 23rd the decision was made to divest KRSA from SEND and the

NLN. It will be sold to another Christian broadcasting entity to continue to serve its listeners but will no longer be a destina-

tion for SEND missionaries.

Therefore, we have been re-assigned from Petersburg to Glennallen, Alaska to serve at two radio stations.

The first is the NLN's flagship station and winner of Focus on the Family's 2009 Small Market Station of the Year Award, KCAM. Providing necessary communications and delivering the Gospel message to a broad audience, it stands as a community lighthouse.

The second is a new and exciting venture called KVRM (Village Radio Ministry). Its objective is to gain access to the native population that has

not yet been reached with the Gospel. All music and on-air personnel will be native Alaskan, speaking the dialect of the

people as Jesus did. It's ministry should be most effective in overcoming the stigma of

the "white-man's religion." The transmitter and studios are currently under construction.

One of several benefits to result from this change of fields: our financial requirement has been reduced by over \$300 per month!

Please help us reach our next milestone: 25% of required monthly pledges. This will allow us to participate in SEND's Family Medical Plan. Currently, our family is without adequate coverage.

The 'wall' above represents our total monthly financial requirements. The dark red 'bricks' represent Partners that have made Faith Promises in the corresponding amounts. We have **64 contributors** overall: **33** have made **Faith Promise pledges** totaling **16%** needed; the rest have made **Special Contributions**, raising our **Outgoing** funds to **48%**.  
 A side note about our Outgoing Account: the *sooner* we have our monthly Faith Promises pledged, the *less* we will need for Outgoing, helping us to *get on-field* and make a difference sooner!

## Pick a brick, save a soul

In the book of Nehemiah, the prophet was distressed by the condition of the wall around Jerusalem and was led by God to rebuild it. Although he had no idea how to do it, he trusted that God would accomplish the task through him.

He boldly requested of the king of the land where he was exiled for building materials and every other provision, and it was given him.

Then he returned to his homeland and told his people what the Lord had instructed.

Each person then repaired a portion of the wall. The task was completed in 52 days!

Like Nehemiah's mission, it is impossible for us to carry out this assignment on our own.
